PURPOSE

To create a network of Richmonders who are inspired to use their daily work to seek the common good of their city.

WHAT WE DO

- **CULTIVATE:** Inspire and equip existing leaders and institutions in Richmond to develop habits that foster the common good.
- **CREATE:** Help Richmonders imagine and advance expressions of the common good through vocational initiatives in their spheres of influence.
- **CURATE:** Celebrate and promote the stories and best practices of those advancing the common good, in Richmond and around the world.
- **COLLABORATE:** Foster cooperation among vocations, industries, denominations, races, socio-economic classes, and neighbors across Richmond toward the common good.
- **CONVENE:** Gather diverse cross-sections of people to explore how to bring renewal and flourishing to Richmond as they pursue their daily work.

KEY TERMS

- **COMMON GOOD:** Flourishing for *all*—to work for the common good of Richmond is to work in ways that promote the flourishing of everyone in our city.
- **VOCATION:** The responsibilities, activities, and relationships to which we are called and which we pursue daily.

PLANNING TEAM

Common Good RVA desires to establish an active and diverse (with regards to gender, race, socio-economics, and denominational affiliation) planning team to advance its overall purpose of inspiring and equipping Richmonders to use their daily work for the common good of Richmond.

PLANNING TEAM MEMBER ROLE DESCRIPTIONS:

All planning team members will serve a 2-year term (academic year).

They will:

- Participate in monthly meetings (8 per year)
- Grow in understanding of and commitment to the purpose of Common Good RVA
 - By reading website content
 - Through conversation with existing Planning Team Members
- Serve as hosts for annual conference
 - By inviting others
 - By publicizing within one's own faith community as well as within greater Richmond
 - By offering day-of support along availability and giftedness
- Attend two quarterly Common Good RVA forums
- Participate on one sub-committee of the Planning Team
 - Engagement Team (website, social media, etc.)
 - Annual Conference Team
 - Quarterly Forum Team
 - Community Partnership Team
- Leverage personal network in support of Common Good RVA events and vision
